## **Article I.**

### **Introductory provisions**

- 1) This document sets out a set of basic safety instructions and rule describing the recommended response and behaviour when managing extraordinary events and crisis situations at the university buildings at the Dejvice Campus (ie Buildings A, B, C).
- 2) The provided safety instructions and rules in the form of a Manual are intended for all employees and students of UCT Prague at the Dejvice Campus.
- 3) The aim of the Manual is to enhance safety awareness and familiarise all employees and students of UCT Prague with the potential security risks in the form of extraordinary events and crisis situations that may occur, and, most importantly, how to behave in case they occur.
- 4) This document is prepared in compliance with Directive No. A/S/961/9/2025 'Crisis Preparedness of UCT Prague'.
- 5) Safety instructions and rules are provided in a separate annex 'Manual for managing extraordinary events and crisis situations at the Dejvice Campus'.
