In compliance with the statement of the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports of the Czech Republic, the University of Chemistry and Technology, Prague (hereinafter "UCT Prague") **cancels** the requirement to submit Recognition of Higher Education and Qualifications Acquired Abroad pursuant to Sections 89, 90 and 90a of the Act No. 111/1998 Coll. on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendment to Other Acts when entering in employment relations (PP, DPČ, DPP work contracts) in case of professions which, pursuant to Act No. 18/2004 Coll. on the recognition of professional qualifications and other competences of nationals of Member States of the European Union and nationals of other countries and on the amendment to some other acts (Act on the Recognition of Professional Qualifications), do not fall into the category of regulated activities¹ under Section §3, paragraph 1, letter e) of the Act.

For the purposes of pursuing a profession at UCT Prague, job candidates with completed foreign education shall, if not required otherwise on an individual basis, submit the original of their higher education degree, including the diploma supplement, if issued, or the certified copy thereof. If the diploma is not in the Czech or the English languages, an officially certified translation thereof shall be submitted.
