Study programmes ECTS allocation:

1 full academic year	60 credits
1 semester	30 credits

To enroll in the next semester of the study program, the student must always **complete at least 15 credits** in the previous semester in compulsory and compulsory-elective subjects.

In order to enroll in the last semester of the study program, the student must have completed all compulsory and compulsory-elective subjects from already completed semesters.

Students with a study average of 1,0–1,8 are eligible to apply for the Excellent study results scholarship.
