#### I.

In compliance with Section 58 Paragraph 2 of Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments of and Supplements to Other Acts (Higher Education Act), as amended, the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports of the Czech Republic announced on January 26, 2023 the base for setting the fees related to study for the academic year 2023/2024 at the amount of **CZK 4,657** (in words four thousand six hundred and fifty-seven Czech crowns).

According to this base and in compliance with Appendix 2, Fees Related to Study at UCT Prague, to the internal regulation “Statute of the University of Chemistry and Technology, Prague”, the amounts of fees related to study are for the academic year 2023/2024 as follows:

In the academic year 2023/2024, a student studying in a bachelor´s or follow-up master´s study programme falling into the education area Chemistry, Economics, or Food Science for more than the standard term of study increased by one year shall pay for the term of the first twelve months a fee equal to four times the base, i.e. the amount of CZK 18,628 rounded up to **CZK 18,700** (in words eighteen thousand seven hundred Czech crowns) for each commenced six months of study; in the following years the student shall pay eight times the base, i.e. the amount of CZK 37,256 rounded up to CZK **37,300** (in words thirty-seven thousand three hundred Czech crowns) for each commenced six months of study.

A student studying in a study programme provided in a foreign language shall pay a fee under Section 58 Paragraph 4 of the Higher Education Act. In compliance with Appendix 2, Fees Related to Study at UCT Prague, of the internal regulation “Statute of the University of Chemistry and Technology, Prague”, the amount of the fee for studying in a study programme provided in a foreign language and falling into the education area Chemistry or Food Science, shall be for the academic year 2023/2024 sixteen times the base, i.e. CZK 74,512 rounded up to **CZK 74,600** (in words seventy-four thousand six hundred Czech crowns).

The amount of the fee for studying in a study programme provided in a foreign language and falling into the education area Economics shall be for the academic year 2023/2024 **CZK 90,000** (in words ninety thousand Czech crowns).

Doctoral study programmes provided in a foreign language are in the academic year 2023/2024 free of charge.

**Waiver, reduction, deferment or division in several payments of fees related to study.**

Within the process of deciding on revision of the decision regarding charging a fee related to study, the Rector may waive, reduce, defer or divide the payment of the above stated fees, taking into account award of study results scholarship or social scholarship, extremely difficult study, social, health or family situation of the student and extraordinary professional or social representation of UCT Prague.

The Rector decides on the waiver, reduction or deferment of the fee based on the student's written appeal raised within 30 days of notification of the Dean's decision to charge the fee related to study; the appeal shall contain an attachment containing documents providing reasons for the appeal.

Further information, if necessary, shall be provided by the Department of Education.
